


You are invited to a special free concert on-line or in person!

Background: Two decades ago, the messianic worship group *Voice of the Shepherd* recorded an album of original Scripture-based messianic music. Their songs were briefly played on one of the top Christian radio stations in America. After a 25-year hiatus, the Lord unexpectedly restarted the group in a miraculous way. *Voice of the Shepherd* was recently the subject of a 2-page feature story in the Messianic Times.
